The roundabout is part of a larger project that includes freight improvements along U.S. 20 between Burns and Ontario. The project will be designed this year and constructed in 2023.

Comments received included concerns about freight access through a roundabout, impacts to local property owners, roundabout safety and suggestions to install a traffic signal. Each of these issues will be discussed during the July 15 meeting. We hope to see you there.
