ESSER funds were used to support a digital navigator program, in which HSD families are taught how to use technology so they can better stay informed about what is happening at their child's school and around the district, check their student's grades/homework, and learn more about supports and services available to them. Digital navigators assist students with accessing technology/their Chromebooks during the day as well as providing training for families on how to assist their students. (Pictured above)



ESSER funds were used to fund a full-time teacher on special assignment (TOSA) position for HSD's Diploma Plus program, which is available from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m. on weekdays to assist students who would otherwise be at risk for not graduating with attaining the credits they need.



ESSER funds were used to fund a full-time TOSA for elementary Career and College Pathways integration. This person is coordinating with the Hillsboro Schools Foundation to provide each elementary classroom with age-appropriate career kits containing diverse and culturally relevant materials that connect to their Language Arts curriculum.
