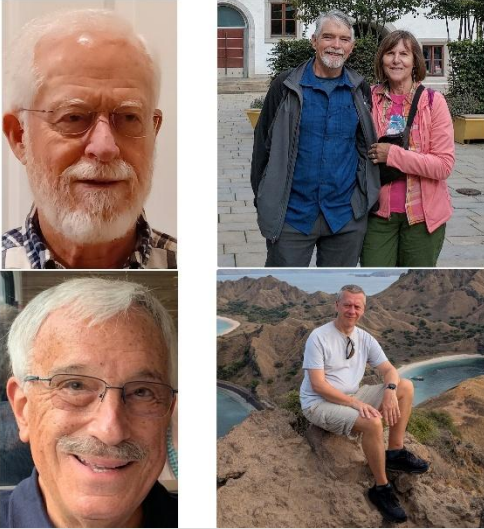


## Deschutes County Medical Reserve Corps Honorees
