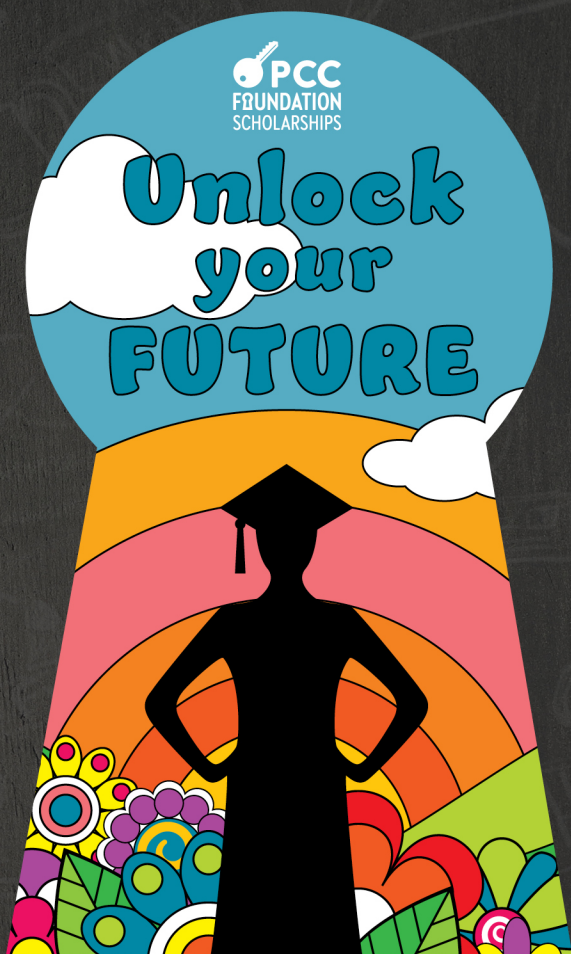

PCC OMIC Training Scholarships

The PCC OMIC Scholarship is intended to support students from Columbia County interested in education and training for careers in advanced manufacturing, including Pre-Trades programs, Machine Manufacturing Technology, Welding Technology, and Computer Aided Drafting & Design. Scholarship funds can be used to support tuition, fees, books, and required tooling.

In order to start a PCC Foundation Scholarship Application, students need to first be admitted to PCC. Admission to PCC is automatic by filling out the application. Once admitted, students will be assigned a G#, which is their unique student ID number, and needed to begin the scholarship application.

Supplemental Questions

Essay info: (350 words max each)

1. Explain your career goals and your educational plan to meet these goals. What inspired you to choose this field of study and career?
2. What is your greatest strength or characteristic and how will this help you to be successful at PCC?

Letter of reference (not required but worth bonus points)

You'll need the name and email address of the person providing recommendation. Identify them early and have them ready so you can put them into the system on November 1. They will have until February 1 to submit their reference, but they can have it prepped and ready to go earlier.
