Course Description:

Hosted by the Emergency Management Institute (EMI) and FEMA Region 10, this five-day, virtual course is intended to assist individuals and jurisdictions who desire to develop or improve their Emergency Operation Centers (EOC). Upon completion of this course, students will be able to demonstrate through activities and a final exam, the managerial and operational roles of the modern-day EOC as a National Incident Management System (NIMS) Command and Coordination functional group operating within a Multiagency Coordination System (MACS).

Prerequisites:

Required prerequisites include Independent Study (IS) courses <u>IS-100</u>, <u>IS-700</u>, <u>IS-800</u>, and <u>IS-2200</u>. Recommended prerequisites include E/L/G-191 and <u>IS-200</u>.

Tuition is free for those accepted; there are no travel/salary stipends available and all incurred costs are the responsibility of the attendee or sending organization.

Federal, state, tribal, territorial, local level, business and nongovernmental emergency management personnel who may be designated to support an EOC within their jurisdiction or organization.
