THE NAACP's **ACADEMIC, CULTURAL, TECHNOLOGICAL AND SCIENTIFIC OLYMPICS (ACT-SO)** is a yearlong achievement program designed to recruit, stimulate, and encourage high academic and cultural achievement among minority high school students. ACT-SO includes 32 competitions in performing, visual and culinary arts, business, humanities, and stem. Be among the 300,000 high school students who have participated in the program.

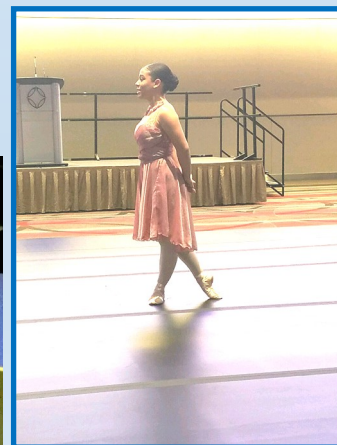

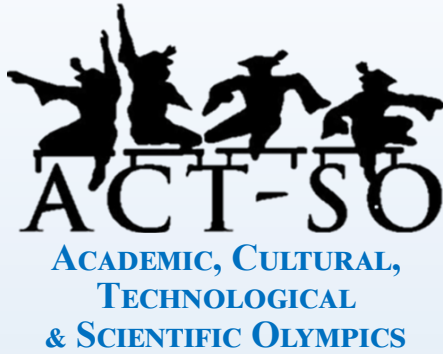
