

Memphis/Shelby County Continuum of Care Funding Availability Announcement

With the release of the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development is making available approximately \$2.3 billion in Fiscal Year 2019 for the Continuum of Care (CoC) Program nationwide.

The CoC Program is designed to promote community-wide planning and strategic use of resources to address homelessness; improve coordination and integration with mainstream resources and other programs targeted to people experiencing homelessness; improve data collection and performance measurement; and allow each community to tailor its programs to the particular strengths and challenges in assisting homeless individuals and families within that community.

Applications for new projects in Memphis and Shelby County, including applications from organizations that have not previously received CoC Program funding, are being accepted **until August 19, 2019 at 4:00 pm**. All project applications must be submitted in e-snaps, the electronic grants management system used by HUD's Office of Special Needs Assistance Programs (SNAPS), which is accessible at <https://www.hudexchange.info/programs/e-snaps/>.
