The Referendum: Where do we go from here?

- Sales tax increase recently passed, and it is our responsibility and intention to implement the will of the voters.
- To put things into perspective, the transition process of comprehensive pension and healthcare reform took nearly two years from 2014-2016.
- Proposed to fund three things:
 - Public safety
 - Pre-k
 - Road improvements

Who is included?

- Police Officers
- Firefighters
- Paramedics
- Police and Fire Dispatchers

What benefits will change?

- Pension—limited number (less than 750).
 - Police officers, Firefighters, Paramedics, and Police and Fire dispatchers hired January 1, 2009—July 1, 2016.
- Insurance—all current, future, and retired
 Police officers, Firefighters, Paramedics, and
 Police and Fire dispatchers.
 - Pre-65 retirees
 - Elimination of spousal carve-out

When will they take effect?

- Pension—estimated time to implementation by January 1, 2021—subject to State approval (State Treasurer).
- Medical insurance—RFP will be issued in Spring of 2020. Open enrollment will begin Fall of 2020 with benefits taking effect January 2021.

Challenge

 Currently, approximately 600 police and firefighters are eligible for retirement today.
