VOTE BY MAIL

If you are eligible to vote with a mail-in-ballot and want to vote this way, you must request one by October 23. When mailing in your ballot, it must be postmarked by November 3 and received no later than the day after Election Day. Call 888-839-8682 for drop-off options available in your county.

Only the following categories of people are eligible to vote by mail: individuals who are 65 years or older; those who are disabled or unable to go to a polling place due to illness; individuals out of the county on Election Day and during the period for early voting; or individuals confined in jail, but otherwise eligible.

Please note that fear of contracting COVID-19 does not make one eligible under the disability or illness clause.
