

Trans Kids and Families of Texas Scholarship Application

for eligible graduates pursuing vocational, or freshman or sophomore college curriculum

Texas Trans Kids & Families of Texas will be offering three \$1000 scholarships to be used for continuing education after high school graduation. To be eligible to receive a scholarship from TKFofTX, the student must meet the following qualifications:

- Be an openly self-identified transgender or gender non-conforming student.
- High School graduate or freshman rising to sophomore in the year they apply for a scholarship.
- Be a resident of the state of Texas.
- Be a United States Citizen or be a legal immigrant.
- Have a plan to attend an accredited college, university, or vocational school within the United States or Canada. Proof of acceptance is required.
- Provide an OFFICIAL copy of their high school or college transcript. A signed document from parent for home school students will be accepted.
- Complete 1 personal essay as outlined on the application form.
- Provide at least 2 letters of recommendation from non-family members.
- Prepare a list of community involvement, achievements and work experience.
 Extra merit is given to those activities and leadership roles relating directly to the Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Non-binary and Transgender communities.
- Previous recipients are not eligible.

All decisions of the selection committee are final. Scholarship proceeds are given directly to the student and/or guardian.

Sign an acknowledgement form agreeing to the outlined terms and conditions of

the application. (See application form)

A committee appointed from the LGBTQ+ community will determine selections. The decision will be based on a weighted scale as follows:

- List of community involvement, achievements, work experience & GPA 35%
- Essay (500 words or less) 40%
- Letters of Recommendation 25%

Letter of Recommendation

Please attach (2) letters of recommendation from an adult, **two people** <u>not related to you.</u> The letters of recommendation are worth 25% of your evaluation. The letters should include the nature of the writer's relationship with you and the length of time they have known you.

Essay

The essay portion of your scholarship application is worth 40% of your evaluation. This essay must not exceed 500 words. Answers to the essay question/prompt may be neatly handwritten in ink or typed separately and attached to the scholarship application. If the essay is typed, please use a minimum of 14-point font and double space. Also, do not include your name on the essay page. If your name appears, we will black out all name references named on the essay page before providing the essay to the review committee. Please base your essay on the following prompt:

Describe a problem you've solved or a problem you'd like to solve. It can be an intellectual challenge, a research query, an ethical dilemma – anything that is of personal importance, no matter the scale. Explain its significance to you and what steps you took or could be taken to identify a solution.
