A Statement of Shared Goals Between the City of Dallas and The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania


As the United States and the United Republic of Tanzania (Tanzania) mark more than 60 years of diplomatic cooperation, the people of the City of Dallas (Dallas) and Tanzania continue to work together toward achieving shared interests.

Through this letter, Dallas and Tanzania mutually express a desire to expand commerce, tourism, and cultural ties in their respective jurisdictions. Accordingly, the undersigned parties agree to a collaborative work plan to accomplish the following goals:


1. Establishing a physical trade office in Dallas to promote trade with East African countries.
2. Establishing a formal agreement to promote tourism and cultural exchanges between Dallas and Tanzania.
3. Engaging Dallas Fort Worth International Airport and relevant airlines to establish direct cargo and passenger routes between Dallas and Tanzania.
4. Collaborating on a future trade mission led by Mayor Johnson to Tanzania during his tenure in office.

The undersigned agree to work to develop a plan to accomplish these areas of common interest over the next (6) six months.
