**Registration and Title Bulletin # 004-17
Policy and Procedure**

TO: All County Tax Assessor-Collectors

SUBJECT: Waiver of Fees for Replacement Registration Sticker and/or License Plate(s)

PURPOSE

To provide information on a new exception to payment of fees for replacement of a registration sticker and/or license plate(s).

DETAILS

House Bill 2663, enacted by the 85th Regular Session, Texas Legislature, amended Transportation Code §§502.060(b) and 504.007 to allow a new exception to payment of fees for replacement of a registration sticker and/or license plate(s). The replacement and automation fees are not due if a county tax assessor-collector determines the vehicle owner did not receive the registration sticker and/or license plate(s) that were mailed. This new exception is effective immediately.

COUNTY ACTION

When a customer requests replacement of a registration sticker and/or license plates, the replacement and automation fees should be waived if a county tax assessor-collector determines the vehicle owner did not receive the registration sticker and/or license plate(s) that were mailed.
