TO: All County Tax Assessor-Collectors

SUBJECT: Barcode Page and Application Assembly Procedures for Imaging

PURPOSE

To inform you of a new barcode page, and to provide you with updated exempt registration, personalized dealer license plates, and qualifying specialty license plates application assembly procedures and mailing instructions.

DETAILS

Currently, exempt registration, personalized dealer license plates, and qualifying specialty license plates applications, along with proof of eligiblity documents, and Registration and Title System (RTS) receipts are sent to the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV), Special Plate Unit, to prepare for imaging. RTS Release 9.5, scheduled for go-live December 16th, includes a change that streamlines the imaging process.

Beginning with RTS Release 9.5, a new barcode page will print automatically with the issuance of receipts when processing initial exempt registration, personalized dealer license plates, and qualifying specialty license plates application transactions. The barcode page will include the new license plate number, customer name, plate type, and a barcode used for imaging purposes. The barcode page must be attached to the front of the assembled exempt registration, personalized dealer license plates, or qualifying specialty license plates application packet. The packet should include proof of eligiblity documents when a qualifying specialty license plate is issued.

Attached are assembly procedures and mailing instructions to use when sending exempt registration, personalized dealer license plates, and qualifying specialty license plates applications to be imaged. The attached procedures include a complete list of applications that are required to be sent to the department for imaging.

COUNTY ACTION

Please begin following the attached assembly procedures and mailing instructions when sending exempt registration, personalized dealer license plates, or qualifying specialty license plates applications and proof of eligiblity documents to be imaged. This change is effective with transactions processed in RTS beginning December 16th.
