These Release Notes contain information about new features, enhancements, and reported issues resolved in this release of eLICENSING.


## eLICENSING Overview

eLICENSING is an online self-service hub for all motor vehicle dealers, salvage dealers, and industry licensees operating in Texas. Dealers and licensee can access licensing information, submit license applications and payments, and track the progress of submitted applications. Members of the public as well as tax assessor-collectors may use eLICENSING to file complaints against dealers.

### **LACE-10137 215/221 Rule Changes - Add Fingerprinting to Salvage and In-transit**

Salvage and In-Transit license types will now require applicants and their authorized representatives to complete fingerprinting through a DPS-approved vendor upon submission of new and renewal applications, as well as amendment applications to update ownership & management.
