These Release Notes contain information about new features, enhancements, and reported issues resolved in this release of eLICENSING.


eLICENSING Overview

Dealers and licensee can access licensing information, submit license applications and payments, and track the progress of submitted applications. Members of the public as well as tax assessor-collectors may use eLICENSING to file complaints against dealers.
