

The IMS is a web-based application designed to manage license plate inventory and interfaces with the webDEALER application to provide dealers with a way to assign plates in ePLATE.



Impact Analysis by Area:

- **View Inventory:** Enhancements to default data loading and filtering capabilities.
- **Shipment Tracking:** Enhancements to the tracking number, providing access to real-time shipping status.


- **Reporting:** Enhancements to the Inventory Inquiry Report criteria and data display.

1.1 View Inventory Enhancements

DMV-1511	A new Plate Status filter (Available, Unavailable, All) was added to help dealers more easily identify usable inventory and navigate the system more efficiently.
	<p>A new Plate Status filter on the View Inventory screen makes it easier to find usable inventory fast. The In Stock view now displays only Available items, with options to include Unavailable inventory or both Available + Unavailable inventory — giving you clearer visibility and better control in fewer clicks.</p> <p>Plate Status Filter Options</p> <p>Available Only Displays ready to use inventory, in an Available status.</p> <p>Unavailable Only Displays unusable inventory, in an Unavailable status (Assigned to vehicles or flagged as lost/missing, damaged or stolen).</p> <p>All plates Displays plates in both Available and Unavailable statuses.</p> 

1.2 Shipment Tracking Enhancements

	The tracking number now appears in the Order Details screen, and links directly to the carrier’s website—making it easy to view real-time shipment status and delivery details.



1.3 Reporting Enhancements

DMV-1617 & DMV-1698	Reporting enhancements allow dealers to run Inventory Inquiry Reports at both the GDN and location level, filter by plate type, and export results to Excel. Improvements were also made to plate range grouping for better accuracy.
	<p>Enhancements to the Inventory Inquiry Report includes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You can now run reports at the GDN level or by individual locations, giving you the flexibility to view plate inventory across an entire GDN or drill down location by location. 2. Run a report by a specific plate type to get a filtered look at one or more specific plate types across a GDN or individual location. 3. Improvements to how sequential and non-sequential plate ranges are displayed in the report provide better accuracy with inventory tracking and counts.
