Enhancements in Release 26.2

New ID Requirements for Title Applications with Initial Registration

Dealers completing a title transaction with initial registration will need to identify what type of identification is presented by the buyer.

Dealers must enter one of the following buyer identification details on the Seller Disclosure page.

The identification types and identification numbers that are required include:

- **Driver's License/ID Card**
 - Identification number
 - State of issuance
 - Identification Type
 - Is this a REAL ID? Yes/No

- **Foreign Passport**
 - Identification number
 - Country of issuance

Voluntary Indicator Identifying U.S. Armed Forces Membership as Part of the Title & Registration Application Process

Automatically unassign dealer plate when License Plate Assignment is processed

The system will now automatically unassign a dealer plate when a License Plate Assignment is processed. When the dealer goes to the License Plate Assignment page and a dealer plate is still assigned to the vehicle, the users will now encounter the warning message below and the dealer can continue to proceed with the License Plate Assignment process.

Removal and addition of scenarios in the LPA process for ePLATE

The Registration Class List located on the License Plate Assignment- Sales Information page has been updated to accommodate various scenarios to ensure the appropriate vehicle class and registration class options align with the dealer license type.

For example, trailer/semitrailer dealers are no longer able to select 06-Apportioned, 16- MICS Farm Trailer and 37- MISC Trailer from the “Registration Class List” drop down menu in the ePLATE license plate assignment process.

Enabling provisional license plate assignments for vehicles sold to Exempt entities

Dealers now have the ability to assign a provisional plate for vehicles obtaining regular exempt registration.

Users must select the General Issue Plate option and the appropriate registration class from the Registration Class List drop-down menu, the user will then select the Retrieve Inventory button, and the Regular Exempt check box will populate. Users will select the check box for regular exempt and complete the required fields.





Duplicate plates added to IMS via VTN

The system will not allow dealers to complete a Vehicle Transfer Notice (VTN) for a vehicle they have already submitted a VTN on and the plates were already added to their inventory. This includes instances when:

- the plate from a VTN submitted by the dealer was already assigned to a vehicle by the dealer.
- the plate from a VTN was not assigned to a vehicle within 20 days and no longer available for assignment.

In these instances, dealers will receive the error message below:
