



Certification of Texas Legal Domicile/Residence by Active-Duty Military

Instructions

Completion of this document allows Active-Duty members of the U.S. Armed Forces, who claim Texas as their legal domicile/residence, to register their motor vehicle without providing a Texas address.

Certifications will be confidentially shredded, once received and processed, by the department. If submitted to your local county tax assessor-collector's office, in person, this form will be returned to the applicant upon verification. If submitted by mail, the county tax assessor-collector's office will confidentially shred the form after verification.
