

# Standard Curriculum

- Jailer Course: 120 hours of instruction
- Telecommunicator Course: 80 hours of instruction
  - » These hours can be conducted in a variety of instructional scheduling models approved by TCOLE.
  - » Instructor must be a TCOLE certified instructor and have subject matter expertise in the area of the course they are instructing.

## Class Location

- Instruction will take place in an approved ISD classroom or at an approved contract provider location based on the needs of each individual program.

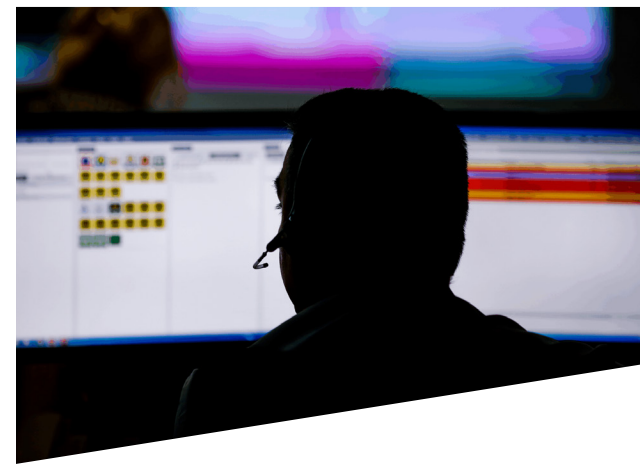

## High School Criminal Justice Pipeline Program



## Program Overview

- Prepares high school seniors for licensure as a Jailer or Telecommunicator in the State of Texas.
- Contract between TCOLE, a TCOLE contracted service provider/training academy, and the local school district.
- State licensing examination may be taken upon successful completion of the course, once the candidate reaches 18 years old and upon successful graduation from high school.

## Student Participation Requirements

### To take the class:

- U.S. Citizen
- 18 years of age within 180 days of completion of the program
- Pass fingerprint/background check
- Be present for all 120 hours of instruction (missed hours to be made up)

### To take the exam:

- Successful completion of course
  - Be 18 years old
  - High School graduate
- \* The state-mandated physical and psychological exam (L-2 and L-3) will be coordinated by the hiring agency after passing the licensing exam.
