The <u>Community Engagement Office</u> provides support and assistance to Fort Worth's many neighborhood associations. The office is staffed by Liaisons who work with residents and City staff to solve neighborhood problems.

Liaisons help residents establish community organizations such as Neighborhood Associations and Alliances, answer questions about neighborhood concerns, connect residents with City services, and help association leaders troubleshoot issues related to their association or their neighborhood.

The Community Engagement Office also can provide training for your association. Topics include:

- New officer training
- Outreach and volunteer recruiting
- How to hold an effective neighborhood meeting
- Ways to communicate with your membership
- Bylaws revisions
- Establishing a new association

Your Liaison also can provide presentations or a speaker on numerous City service topics, such as:

- Crime prevention
- Code compliance
- Garbage & recycling
- Water conservation
