- (d) An operation must not prohibit government personnel performing their official duty from entering the operation, unless the individual meets the above screening criteria.
- (e) The pick-up and drop-off of children must be completed outside of the operation, unless the operation determines that there is a legitimate need for the parent to enter. Should the parent have a legitimate need to enter the operation, the parent must be screened by the operation as provided in subsection (c).
- (f) An operation must not serve family style meals. Each child must be provided individual meals and snacks.
- (g) If this emergency rule is more restrictive than any minimum standard relating to the operations addressed by this rule, this emergency rule will prevail so long as this emergency rule is in effect.
- (h) If an executive order or other direction is issued by the Governor of Texas, the President of the United States, or another applicable authority, that is more restrictive than this emergency rule or any minimum standard relating to the operations addressed in this emergency rule, the operations must comply with the executive order or other direction.
