


CWD TESTING

***Note:** All CWD test results will be uploaded directly to TWIMS from Texas A&M Veterinarian Medical Diagnostic Laboratory (TVMDL). All samples sent for testing must be accompanied by a TWIMS generated accession form.

Create a TVMDL Accession Form for Post-Mortem Tests:

Note: A deer must be reported dead in TWIMS before it can be added to an accession form. Refer to page 57 for instructions on reporting a deer's death.

1. Click on the "CWD Monitoring" tab.
2. Click on the appropriate facility ID in which the deer died.



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

Include this accession form with all tissue samples and deliver as a package to TVMDL for testing. The TVMDL Accession Form must be submitted along with the tissue samples to ensure timely processing of the test results. Ensure that all tissue sample containers are clearly marked with the appropriate unique ID number.

(Continued) Create a TVMDL Accession Form for Post-Mortem Tests:

6. Provide the “Sample Collection Date” and “Tissue Type” information. If multiple samples were collected on the same date, use the “Apply to All” section at the top. Enter the “Sample Collection Date” and click “Apply.” Then enter the “Tissue Type” and click “Apply.” Alternatively, specific “Sample Collection Date” and “Tissue Type” information that differs for each deer can be entered using the appropriate fields in line with each deer in the list.
