## Coastal Grassland Restoration Incentive Program (C-GRIP)

## **C-GRIP Eligibility Requirements:**




Figure 1. C-GRIP focal areas.

- 1. Treatment area is at least partially located in a focal area (Figure 1).
- 2. Treatment area is on private land.
- 3. Treatment area is at least 25 acres in size.
- 4. Treatment(s) being proposed are on the eligible practice list and in accordance with C-GRIP Project Manager recommendations.
- 5. Landowner agrees to contribute to the project an amount equal to the amount they will receive in C-GRIP funding.
- 6. Maximum amount for individual projects is \$50,000.
- 7. Long-Term Potential must meet at least one to qualify:
  - Landowner is committed to maintaining improved state of habitat in project area for at least 5 years after project completion.
  - Property is under a natural resource conservation easement.

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## **Available Funding and Proposal Submission Process:**

We are currently have \$55,500 remaining in two NGO accounts (\$36,000 and \$19,500) and are accepting project proposals for these funds. The proposal submission process is handled through a combination of the C-GRIP Project Proposal Form and the C-GRIP Treatment Details Form. Project managers can find these forms on the C-GRIP website (<a href="www.cgrip.org">www.cgrip.org</a>), then follow these instructions:

- 1. Project managers should fill out the C-GRIP Project Proposal Form.
- 2. Project managers, in coordination with the participating landowner fill out the C-GRIP Treatment Details Form for each treatment area in the proposed project. Treatment Details Forms for each separate treatment area can be combined and submitted as a single project.
- 3. In the C-GRIP Treatment Details Form include a map of the project area that clearly shows where treatments are to occur.
- 4. Submit project proposal packet to C-GRIP Coordinator Steve DeMaso at steve demaso@fws.gov.

After project proposals are submitted, the C-GRIP Coordinator collects them and forwards them on to C-GRIP Review Committee. A call for projects and their subsequent reviews is contingent on funding availability.
