### Submitting your application

- Mail via the U.S. Postal Service **or** drop off the application in-person at your local voter registrar's office.

- Your voter registration will become effective **30 days** after it is received or on your 18th birthday, whichever is later. You must register by the 30th day before Election Day to vote in that election.

- If you move to another county, you must re-register in the county of your new residence.

### Qualifications to vote

- Be a United States citizen.
- Be at least 17 years and 10 months old to register, and you must be 18 years of age by Election Day.
- Not be finally convicted of a felony, or if you were convicted, you have fully discharged your sentence, including any term of incarceration, parole, supervision, period of probation, or you must have been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disability to vote.
- Not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.
- Complete this application for the county you reside in.
