

College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) Verifier



Q: What is the CCMR Verifier?

The CCMR Verifier provides districts an opportunity to verify the accuracy of their CCMR data and, if needed, submit official documentation to correct data. CCMR data is shown for 2018–19 annual graduates and non-graduating 12th graders. Typically these data are used to determine academic accountability ratings; however, due to districts and campuses receiving a Not Rated: Declared State of Disaster label for 2020, the data are report only in the Texas Academic Performance Report this year.



Q: What action is required?

Districts are required to verify CCMR outcomes provided by testing vendors and outside entities for 2018–19 annual graduates and non-graduating 12th graders. If the district does not find any discrepancies or wish to request changes, no action is required. If discrepancies are found, districts must request changes with supporting documentation. Please note, CCMR indicators determined by TSDS PEIMS submissions are not eligible for corrections, and therefore, are not shown.



Q: Where can I find the CCMR Verifier?

After logging into TEA Login (TEAL), approved users can access the Accountability application. In the Accountability application, users can access the Verifier via the 2020 College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) link on the ACCT tab or within the New Items box on the Welcome page.



Q: How do I use the CCMR Verifier?

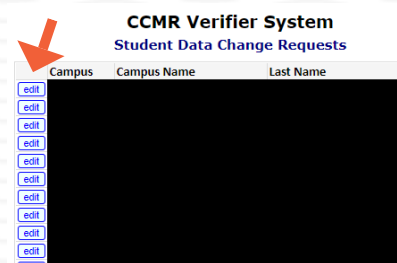
1. Select a campus on the left side of the page:
