## P-EBT Local Level Funding Application Now Open

The Texas Department of Agriculture is now accepting applications to cover local costs incurred for activities related to the FY 2021 State Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT).

This is the first of three expense request forms. This first form covers costs incurred from **October 1, 2020 - May 21, 2021**.

Deadline: **May 21, 2021**.

Schools can expect their first payment to be received in **June 2021**.

You may choose not to submit this form and submit all expenses during the second collection period that covers costs incurred from **October 1, 2020 - September 30, 2021**. This form will be available in **August 2021**.

Payment for this period is expected in **December 2021** following a third form TDA will use to true up any expected expenses submitted.

Reimbursable costs under this grant include:

- limited salaries of personnel,
- supplies,
- equipment,
- support services (including contracts for staffing or system-related work which shows clear allocation to the FY 2021 P-EBT Program),
- indirect costs, and/or
- other expenses associated with the FY 2021 P-EBT program.

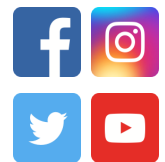
