## Learning About Neglect Event Series 2022

CPCScotland, with support from CELCIS and Scottish Government, will be delivering a series of free, online learning events from March to June 2022. Across four webinars, child protection leaders and practitioners across Scotland will have opportunities to engage with key speakers and organisations on child neglect and practice. This was an area of development identified initially, through the Child Protection Improvement Programme, and more recently within the National Guidance for Child Protection in Scotland and CPCScotland Neglect Sub Group's Framework for Child Neglect in Scotland – Understanding Causes and Supporting Families.

The key themes and practice areas we will be exploring are:

- 17 March Thinking critically about neglect
- 21 April Prebirth and infants
- 19 May Early years and primary school age
- 16 June Young people and adolescents
