The Bereavement Training course focuses on bereavement through drugs or alcohol and the impact it has on bereaved families. The course also covers specific issues around drug-related deaths.

By completing this training you will be able to:

- Define a drug or alcohol-related death.
- Identify key overdose risks.
- Recognise stigma and isolation in relation to a drug or alcohol-related death.
- Recognise practical issues specific to a drug-related death.
- Recognise key messages from Bereaved Through Substance Use¹.
- Recognise self-care and support for the workforce impacted by a drug or alcohol-related death.
