



The impact of recording: How recording causes stigma

Free webinar for foster carers in Wales – March 2023

As foster carers you will come across and read information about children and young people that only focuses on the negative things in their lives. This can create barriers for them to access important services such as education.

With phrases such as 'high risk', 'challenging' and 'attachment issues', it can seem impossible for services to work out how to best support a child or young person, creating unnecessary anxiety and false expectation about what the child or young person is like.

Children and young people deserve to receive services that see who they truly are and are equipped with adequate information. With your support, a child's voice can be central to what is written about them.

Through developing your skills and raising awareness of the impact of recording information, we can overcome barriers that young people face when accessing information and the stigma that is unintentionally caused by negative recording.

Learning outcomes:

- How to record information that authentically represents children and young people.
- Understand how statutory recording influences children and young people's access to services.
- Learn how stigma is created and influences our decision making.
- Recognise how unconscious bias comes to affect behaviour.
- Communicating with children and young people who have experienced trauma.
- Engaging children and young people in recording.
- How to reframe and rephrase information.
