

## Childcare Offer for Wales – Ensuring Continued Eligibility

As part of the Childcare Offer for Wales, parents and guardians must confirm their eligibility each term, as required by the Welsh Government. Notifications are sent to the parent dashboard around the second week of each half term. When parents confirm "no changes" in their application, these applications are subject to a 20% spot check.

Often, parents declare changes, such as becoming unemployed. Therefore, it is crucial to regularly monitor the Agreements section on your Childcare Offer for Wales Dashboard to ensure agreements remain active. **We recommend checking this monthly.**
