Cambridge City

- new social inclusion activities or groups, including transport

- new offers of physical activity for over 65s.

South Cambridgeshire

- new social inclusion activities or groups, including activation of underused communal rooms or halls
- new offers of physical activity for over 65s, including use of green spaces, and
- community transport, especially from rural villages underserved by public transport to Cambridge or Bar Hill.

East Cambridgeshire

- new Good Neighbour Schemes, especially if demand-driven
- new offers of physical activity for over 65s in rural villages, and
- community transport from rural villages underserved by public transport to Ely.

Huntingdonshire

- new social Inclusion activities or groups, especially in North Huntingdonshire
- arts and crafts activities for over 65s across the district
- new offers of physical activity for over 65s, and
- community transport from rural villages underserved by public transport to Huntingdon, St Ives and/or St Neots.

Fenland

- new social inclusion and enrichment activities, including arts, crafts, bowls, technology, gardening, cooking, and further learning
- new offers of physical activity for over 65s
- support for those with dementia and their carers
- information, advice and guidance on local activities and groups, and
- healthy eating/cooking initiatives to support with frailty and diabetes.
