Flower collecting

- Children often love to collect some garden flowers to give to someone special, perhaps you could ask your child why that person is special?
- You could draw a vase on a piece of card and pierce holes in the card for your child to place the flowers in so it looks like they are in a vase.
- If your child has gathered some flowers you could use them to explore counting and colours e.g. how many petals does each flower have? What colours are they? Can they group all the flowers that have 6 petals etc.

ALWAYS check flowers are safe to pick (check the internet for toxic plants and flowers) It is often illegal to pick wild flowers – check first or pick from a garden with permission.
