This week it is... pegs

Monday

One, two, three, four, five...

- Use a wooden peg to make a fish that bites! (see the picture) You could make different coloured fish or different sizes of fish.
- Sing the song '*One, two, three, four, five, once I caught a fish alive...*' to your baby and use the fish peg as a prop, pretending it bites your little finger on the right.
- With older children get them to sing along and they could open and close the fish's mouth by squeezing the peg.
- Older children could hold up fingers as they count.
- You could talk about the different size of fish you've made, which one is the biggest? Which is the smallest? What colours are they? Which is your right hand and which is your left? What are your other fingers called? Do you know any more finger songs? How about Tommy Thumb?
