Stick person

- When you are out and about collect different size and shaped sticks.
- To make a stick person- put one stick across the other to make the arms. You could hold it together with Sellotape/wool/ or a pipe cleaner.
- How will you do their face? You could draw a happy face on your stick or you could stick googly eyes on if you have some.
- Why not make some clothes for your stick person. You could make them out of bits of wool or scrap material that you have around the house.
- When you have made one stick person, maybe you could make a whole stick family!
