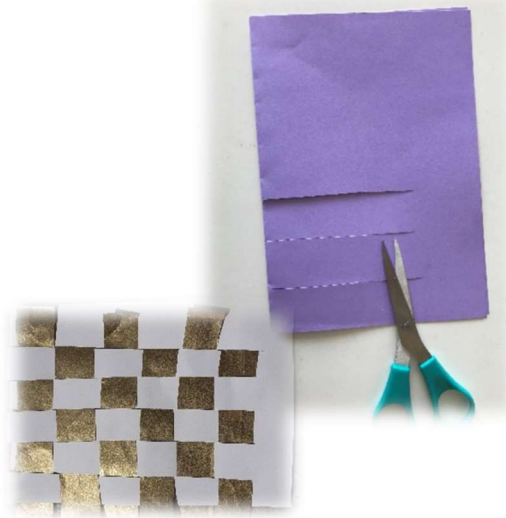

This week it is... paper

Tuesday

Paper weaving

- Save strips of scrap paper to have a go at paper weaving.
- Take a piece of paper and fold it in half.
- Cut evenly spaced slits starting at the folded edge and finishing about an inch from the opposite edge. You could draw lines for children to cut along if they would like a go.
- Unfold the paper and you have a weaving board! (see photos)
- Use the strips of paper to weave in and out of the slits. Make sure your strips of paper are longer than the board so at the end you can fold them over and glue them down to the back.
- Start each strip opposite to the one above e.g. if you started under, start over on the next strip of paper.
