Paper Dolls

- 'The Paper Dolls' by Julia Donaldson is a beautiful book to share with children, if you don't have the book it can be found on YouTube.
- Try making your own paper dolls. Fold a sheet of paper into a concertina (see photo).
- Draw the outline of a simple person – make sure the hands and feet reach the end of the paper and cut out.
- Unfold and you should have a string of paper dolls.
- Draw on clothes, hair and feature – what will you call your paper dolls? Where will they explore in your house or garden?
