

**What can I do
today?**



This week it is...threading

Sunday – fish

- This is an activity for older children.
- You will need: a ruler for measuring, wool or string, card or paper, pen, sticky tape and a hole punch.
- Draw one line along the bottom edge of the page and one going up the vertical edge.
- Mark 9 equal spaces along the lines. Number these along the bottom line from 9-1 and then along the vertical line, the opposite way, from 1-9.
- Using the hole punch put a hole next to each of these marks.
- Using wool thread through the holes from the bottom edge number 9 to the number 1 on the vertical line.
- Now thread to number 2 on the vertical line to number 8 on the bottom line, from number 7 on the bottom line to number 3 on the vertical line and so on until you have made the pattern in the top photograph.
- You can repeat this on the other side of the paper to make a pattern or maybe turn it into a fish by adding an eye and tail.
