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Performance Opportunities: Parade Sunday 15th May 2-4pm.

The parade will be a celebration of the year of culture with artists, community members, volunteers and schools all combining for a mass celebration.

- Opportunities for Primary and Secondary schools to join the parade, which will traverse the inner ring road from Millennium Place to University Square.
- At least 12 places available for schools.
- ‘Ribbons’ is a general theme throughout the parade.
- Schools participation could be light touch or more involved- from mobile dance or gymnastic pieces to just presence with ribbons or flags.
- The Parade will be in 12 sections, each one roughly corresponding to one of the Trust’s monthly themes.
- Small or larger groups (up to 100 approx.) from Schools welcome.
- Entire parade will be 2000+ strong.

- April-Green Futures




Gratte Ciel Performance- 14th and 15th May evenings.

Pioneering Industry: Sadler and Courtaulds Mar 23rd-Apr 13th 2022

Courtaulds, the exemplar factory of Coventry's industrial spirit, inventor of man-made fibres and carbon fibre. This exhibition will focus on important women who worked at the factory, including English chemist and industrial manager Dr Vera Furness. Co-curated with ex-Courtaulds workers.



Pioneering Art: Sadler and the Cathedral May 4th-25th 2022

The inspirational design and art of the Cathedral, coinciding with the 60th anniversary of the Cathedral's consecration. This exhibition will be community-curated with the Friends of Coventry Cathedral. From this we hope that young people will understand why we invest in new artists and how the future inherits these investments.
