# Flame of Friendship

## **Torch Design Competition Briefing**



#### **Overview**

In the run up to the Paris 2024 Olympic/Paralympic Games schools across Coventry will be taking part in a relay run, carrying a bespoke designed torch from school to school, culminating in a final run and mini-parade across the University of Warwick campus and into the Butterworth Hall at Warwick Arts Centre where participating schools will take part in a celebration of the Olympics and Paralympics sharing highlights of our torch relay.

Pupils from primary and secondary schools across Coventry are invited to submit design ideas for the torch.

#### **Prize**

The winning design will be made by WMG at the University of Warwick. The winning team will be invited to a design consultation on the university campus where they will work with technicians from WMG to turn their design into one that can be manufactured. The winning team will have the opportunity to join the first part of the torch run and be welcomed on stage at the celebration in July and introduced to our VIP guests.

The members of the winning and highly commended teams will each win a goody bag and all participating schools will be provided with a set of participation certificates and giveaways for everyone that took part if requested (details will be available on the Flame of Friendship webpage from September 18<sup>th</sup>).

# **Design Brief**

The torch must

- Be carried by people of different ages, different sizes and different abilities.
- Be able to be outside in all weathers.
- Be easy to carry and not slip.
- Contain a live flame please incorporate space in your design for the flame, imagine a cylinder approximately 4cm diameter and 20cm in length (similar to the size and shape of the cardboard centre of a roll of kitchen towel).
- Be representative of friendship and Coventry's heritage.

## **Rules**

To take part in the competition the following rules must be abided by:

- Pupils should work in groups of 2-6 (any age) to come up with one design.
- Schools with under 200 pupils can submit one design.
- Schools with 200 or more pupils can submit two designs.
- How schools choose their winning submission is up to them.

#### The Final Submission

Each submission should include:

- An A3 annotated drawing of the final design, detailing specific aspects of the design e.g. materials, shape etc.
- An A3 background research page showing where they got ideas or inspirations this could include notes and images of materials, inspiration, locations etc., anything that helped shape the final design. Examples of a research page will be available on the Flame of Friendship webpage from September 18<sup>th</sup>.

Submissions should not include:

- Names of schools or individuals on the design or research pages
- 3D models

To make a submission, schools are encouraged to take photos or scans of their design and research pages (if done on paper) and email them to resonate@warwick.ac.uk by 5pm Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2023.

However, we will accept posted pages, these should be sent to the address below (please copy exactly as shown) and be received by Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October. If you are posting we suggest you take photos of your pages and email us to let us know to expect them in the post.
