Session 1:

Learning to Read (and Spell)

What do we teach our pupils with more than mild SEND?

In this first session we will examine the SEND context and answer these questions:

- Why do teachers in mainstream schools need to understand how to meet the needs of pupils with moderate to severe and complex needs?
- Why do teachers in special schools need support to teach phonics?
- What do we teach pupils with moderate to severe and complex needs when we teach them to read and spell? What should a programme look like?

In this second session we answer these questions:

- How do we teach pupils with moderate to severe and complex needs to read and spell?
- How do we make our teaching accessible for pupils with a range of SEND?
- What strategies enable access?

Session 3:

Learning to Read: How do we teach our pupils with complex SEND to blend?

In the third session, we explore how to approach the teaching of blending with pupils with moderate to severe and complex SEND. The session includes looking at a number of useful strategies, some of which are not commonly used in mainstream programmes.
