

# LEARNING PROGRAMMES FOR PRIMARY SCHOOLS

We are the only Holocaust museum in Europe for primary-aged children. We can deliver our programme to any school in the UK: you can visit our beautiful museum in Nottinghamshire; we can come to your school; or your pupils can learn with us online.

Our primary school programmes are based on *'The Journey'*. Pupils follow Leo, a German Jewish child in 1930s Berlin. Leo's character is based on the testimonies of Holocaust survivors.

Pupils learn about the discrimination which led to the Holocaust in an age-appropriate way. They understand why ordinary people continue to become refugees and they consider their own responsibilities today.

However they learn with us, your pupils will have access to our museum collections and the testimony of survivors. Children can handle objects and discover their meanings. You can also choose optional extra workshops that are based on the SATs requirements.

### **AIMS**

- To develop historical knowledge.
- To link the lessons of the Holocaust to the challenges of the present day.
- To encourage critical thinking.

- Live and recorded survivor testimony and opportunities to handle museum artefacts.
- Post-session recorded lesson and access to our Journey App.
- Optional extra workshops based on the SATs requirements.
