

Loudmouth is a Birmingham based theatre in education company, set up in 1994. We specialise in safeguarding work, supporting schools and colleges. We run over 1000 sessions a year across the country with over 100,000 children and young people.

All programmes consist of an hour drama and character Q&A section with class size follow up workshops of 20-40 minutes.

My Mate Fancies You

My Mate Fancies You is a fun and informative programme for years 5 and 6, that teaches children about puberty and the transition to secondary school. The drama and workshop look at the range of physical and emotional changes that take place during puberty and reassure the children that it is a normal and natural process.



Helping Hands

Helping Hands is Loudmouth's gentle and appropriate programme for years 4-6. The programme explores child exploitation and abuse, online safety, domestic abuse and Inappropriate touch.



Loudmouth's Safe Team guide the year group through the NSPCC PANTS rule using a montage of scenes.

In the follow up workshop, the pupils explore the feelings the characters in the dramas had when they didn't feel safe. The facilitators gently explore with the children the different types of abuse shown in the play. The children create their own support network on their hands and discuss ideas of where they would go for support if they felt unsafe.

Bully 4 U

Bully 4 U is Loudmouth's fun and safe education programme on bullying and mental wellbeing for years 3-6. Our Bullybusters help the children learn about bullying and the 5 ways to wellbeing helping the pupils spot and prevent bullying and explore strategies to protect their mental wellbeing.
