



# Supporting High Prior-Attaining Students from Disadvantaged Backgrounds Workshops

Students from socio-economically disadvantaged backgrounds, who previously achieved a high score in maths at Key Stage 2, are far less likely to attain grades 7 to 9 in GCSE Mathematics than their peers.

However, if these students do attain grades 7-9, they are just as likely as other students to progress to and succeed in A level Mathematics.

To address this disparity, the AMSP, in partnership with Maths Hubs, is offering **one-day workshops** focusing on strategies to support high-potential students.
