

SEND Transformation Vision and Strategy.

Devon County Council, Children and Family Health Devon, NHS Devon Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) and colleagues from our partner organisations are working together to transform the experience of children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) and their families, through the SEND Transformation Project.

As part of this work we are developing a new vision and key priorities for the SEND service, to help shape Devon's SEND Strategy for 2021 - 2024.

We recently conducted a survey to gather your views on what the vision and priorities should look like. We received 425 replies from children and young people, parents and carers and professionals. Thank you for taking the time to fill out the survey and for providing such important insight.

Your answers are helping us to finalise the vision and our priorities, and the steps we need to take to put them into action.

As a result of your feedback we have now reshaped the vision:

Our vision is for all children and young people with special educational needs or a disability to **dream, believe and achieve, and fulfil their potential**

The feedback from the survey confirmed that most people agreed with the suggested priorities, and provided us with information on what steps you think we need to take to make our vision a reality.

We are now drafting the SEND strategy, and will be running another survey later in November to ask for your views on the steps we have included within the strategy. We will use this feedback to finalise the SEND Strategy and the associated action plan to deliver it.
