- Are 16 years or over.
- Reside within the Community Council area.
- Are named on the current Register of Electors for your Community Council area.
- Are nominated by one proposer who must also be named on the Register of Electors for your Community Council area.

Please note if you are not already registered as an elector, the last date to register for these elections is 9 August 2024.
