Keeping stakeholders, parents and carers informed about Dudley's Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) Improvement Programme.

Plans for new special school submitted

Plans for a new multi-million pound state of the art special school in Dudley have been submitted.

The plans could see Dudley Council build a £12million special school on the site of the former Pensnett High School to provide education for 115 children and young people aged three to 19 years.

It could replace the existing Pens Meadow Special School which already provides education for pupils with complex needs, including autism and pupils with profound and multiple learning difficulties across two sites.
