PROGRAMME UPDATE

Keeping stakeholders, parents and carers informed about Dudley's Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) Improvement Programme.

9) SEND Work Experience Project

Young people with SEND can struggle to secure work experience and this is a key part of their curriculum to support their transition confidence. Research evidence gained by The Careers & Enterprise Company suggests that work experience is effective in enabling young people and young adults with SEND to make a successful move from school to further or higher education, training, employment or self-employment. The pop up shop work experience will demonstrate the capabilities of young people while providing them with first-hand knowledge of the working environment. The experience will allow our young people to develop key employability skills to support them in their future and enrich their CV's.

The Black Country Careers Hub and Careers and Enterprise company work with schools in the Black Country to get involved in specific projects that support career education, skill development whilst supporting to achieve Gatsby Benchmarks. One of the projects special schools and foundation learning departments is to be involved in a pop up shop work experience. The 'pop up shop' will allow young people with special educational needs and or disabilities to gain access to valuable work experience . Connexions Dudley DMBC is supporting this initiative by sourcing Provision House as an outlet for delivery in the Dudley area. The pop up shop will enable young people to develop their employability skills as pupils are handcrafting items to sell during their enterprise sessions or creating their own marketing campaigns to support them to receive preloved items to sell during their experience.
