DFN Project SEARCH is a one-year Supported Internship programme for young people with an Education, Health and Care (EHC) plan. It is targeted at young people whose goal is competitive employment in the community. Interns will be based within areas at ASDA, Mount Pleasant, Hull.



Entry Requirements:

- You must have an Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP)*.
- You must be aged between 16 and 24 years.
- You must have the desire to achieve full-time employment**.
- Applicants will be required to go through an interview and assessment process to be offered a place on this course.

*If you do not have a EHC plan at the time of the interview, you will need to be in receipt of one by enrolment to be admitted onto the course

**at least 16 hours per week



What you will do:

Interns usually spend one hour in the morning learning employability and life skills before starting their work placement. They will then experience a typical workplace day, working for 5 hours. A catch-up session is included at the end of the day.
