About this event - As part of the RISE Programme, funded by the Department for Education (DfE), the Council for Disabled Children (CDC) have been invited by local leaders in East Riding to deliver a workshop which will focus on developing a local framework for coproduction.

- Learning from good practice regarding co-production elsewhere in the country.
- Agreeing key principles, values and approaches for co-production in East Riding.
- Co-developing a one-page framework and plan for co-production in East Riding.
