Welcome to the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme

There's lots of funded activities available for children and young people aged 5-16 years who attend an East Riding school in the winter holidays. Why not burn off some energy on our sports, dance and football camps, or relax at our farm and craft experiences? You could also learn a new skill by taking part in outdoor adventure, cooking or storytelling workshops. Plus, there's glow sports, boccia, caving and den building for pupils with SEND.

All HAF sessions are available for children and young people in receipt of benefits related free school meals who attend an East Riding school, and we also have a small number of places on all programmes for pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan. Your child can attend up to four sessions for free during the winter holidays with a meal provided at each event.

All about HAF

Is my child eligible for the HAF programme?

Just give us a ring on (01482) 394799. Have your National Insurance number or asylum seeker number ready, and we'll check if your child qualifies for benefits-related free school meals.

My child gets free school meals in Foundation, Year 1, and Year 2 – can they join HAF?

While all younger children get universal free meals, HAF is only for families receiving certain benefits (like Universal Credit with income under £7,400, Income Support, etc.), so it depends on your circumstances – we're happy to help check!

Do I have to book all four sessions with the same provider?

Not all at, you can mix and match sessions from different providers. Your child might enjoy a particular activity, or the location might be close to where you live.

Will my child receive a free meal at each session?

Yes, all providers strive to offer a hot meal, but cold options may be available instead. Please speak to the provider about meal choices and inform them of any allergies or intolerances.

What if my child is unwell or can't make it to a session?

No problem, just let the provider know as soon as you can and cancel your booking on Plinth. If your child misses a few sessions without telling them, the provider is likely to cancel future bookings to give other children a chance, especially if there's a waiting list.

What if it looks like all places are fully booked?

Don't worry, there's still hope! Get in touch with the provider as they may have a waiting list and could call you if someone cancels last minute. You must keep one of your HAF places free just in case they can fit you in. Don't forget to keep checking the website regularly – spots often open up when other families cancel.

My child has special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), can they attend HAF sessions?

HAF sessions are open to everyone and not specifically designed for SEND. The delivery partners are happy to make reasonable adjustments to help children and young people feel comfortable and included. If your child has specific needs that may require adjustments, please let the providers know in advance so they can work with you to create the best supportive environment possible. Please ensure that your registration form is also kept up to date.



What happens if the support in place isn't enough for my child?

If your child needs extra help and the adjustments aren't quite enough, please speak to the provider about accompanying your child to the sessions. Some may allow a parent or carer to stay and support their child – especially if you arrange it in advance. Each provider has different rules and insurance policies. Some are happy for you to stay, others might need a DBS check, and a few may not be able to accommodate your request. The most important thing is to ask first-please don't just turn up on the day. A guick call or email can help make sure everything runs smoothly for you and your child. Please note that HAF providers are not CQC registered and cannot offer personal care.

If the provider(s) have additional staff available or your child receives Direct Payments, please email haf@eastriding.gov.uk to request additional support before Friday, 28 **November**. Unfortunately, if neither option is available, we are unable to offer one-toone support during this holiday season.

Can siblings of a child with an EHCP attend HAF too?

Unfortunately not, unless they also qualify for benefits related free school meals or have an EHCP. Some providers offer payable places as shown on the next page. This season, the Family Hubs have funded sibling places on their cookery programmes and Abilite will be inviting siblings to join them for a family pantomime.
